THE FOOD MINISTRY is no longer excepting donations of clothing at this time. We will resume in the spring.

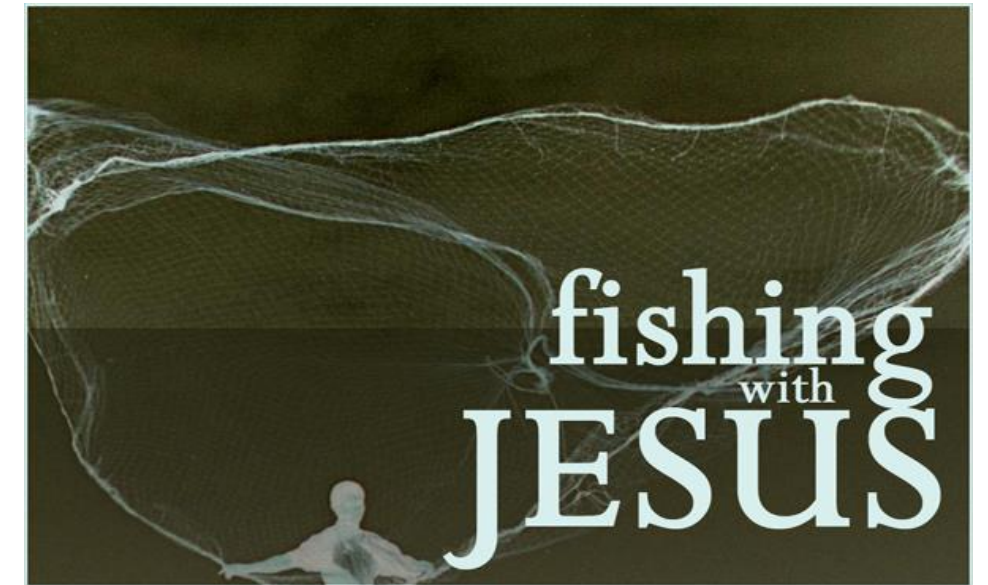
